

Limerick (about 3hrs from Dublin) is a great destination for those interested in architectural and historical places.





We offer English courses at a variety of levels where students can develop language skills in line with the Common European Framework of Reference for languages (CEFR). All our teachers are ACELS accredited and hold a Level 8 NFQ Honours Degree or Level 9 NFQ Masters Degree

Each class has at least two teachers, where one is responsible for the first half, focusing on grammar, and the second teacher is responsible for the second half of the class, focusing on conversation. This method is more dynamic and gives the student a full experience in all nuances of the language. The student will have the opportunity to put into practice everything they learnt and this will help them to memorise the content.


Most of the activities are free while for some of them you just need to pay a small fee or just the transportation fare. Look out for announcements on our social media channels to find out times and information about activities each month.


Health insurance
